This seminar, sponsored by the USPHS Chief Engineer and Engineer Professional Advisory Committee, is open to all categories and follows a very successful previously used format of (1) leadership training by Harry Chambers of Trinity Solutions [www.trinitysol.com] (2) guest lecturers by noted leaders, (3) small group table-top exercises, and (4) a field trip. Logistical support for the seminar is being provided by the Pikes Peak Post of the Society of American Military Engineers. Note, this training is not engineer-specific, but applicable to all PHS officers. Participation is limited to 80.

Among the guest lectures will be a briefing on NORTHCOM/NORAD operations in Colorado Springs, and a lecture on leadership in the Air Force with a focus on leadership training at the Air Force Academy. Attendees will participate in one of two field trips; a tour of the Cheyenne Mountain Operations Center (a high security location) or a guided tour of the Air Force Academy featuring areas not available to the general public. These tours are not optional, but intended to add value to the leadership training.

The registration fee includes the training, tours, an evening reception, and buffet lunch each day. The Crowne Plaza Hotel has a room block for this seminar with rooms costing \$88 per night single or double occupancy (per diem rate), which includes a free hot buffet breakfast, free WiFi, and free airport pick-up. This is a great opportunity to learn about leadership while your family enjoys the amenities at the hotel and surrounding natural attractions.
