The CDC is recruiting a position to serve as Director, of CDC's new National Center for Emerging and Zoonotic Infectious Diseases. The Director is responsible for leading and managing the performance of this complex organization, aligning it with agency goals and objectives, and advancing the state of science through intramural and extramural research in order to continuously improve public health programs through research, innovation, program development, and rigorous performance management and evaluation. The Center Director has broad operating authority and is responsible for overall planning, direction and management of the Center, to include policy formulation, program management and operations, and strategic direction and fiscal oversight for all activities in the Center. The Director provides medical and/or scientific guidance and leadership to international, national, state, and/or local government agencies, universities, and other health-related entities in order to improve critical medical problems/issues, and directs special projects involving medical, technical and scientific matters of interest to the CDC and the Department of Health and Human Services. With the Deputy Director, Office of Infectious Diseases, the incumbent serves as an advisor to the CDC Director on matters pertaining to the Center's mission and areas of expertise, and participates with other top staff in the formulation of broad policies.
